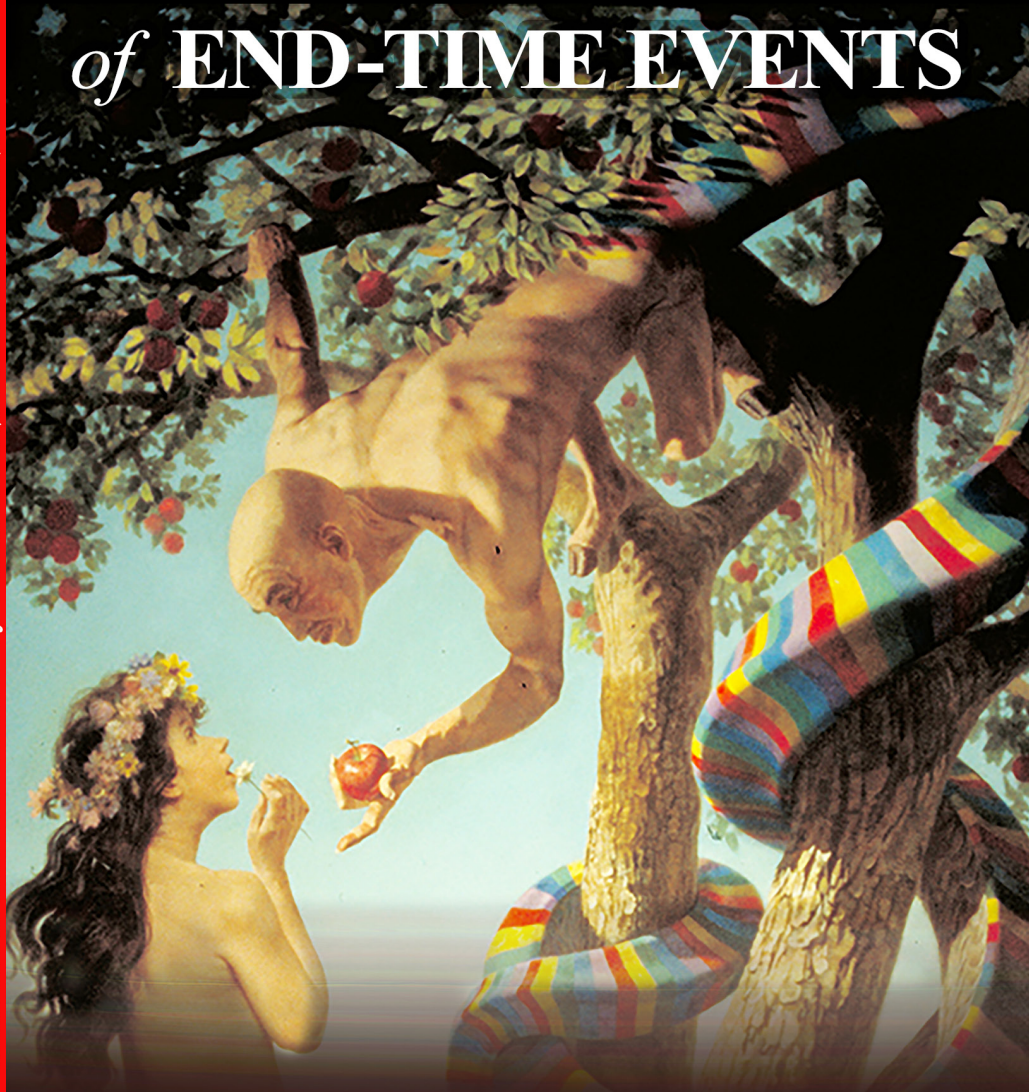

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Prologue

Prophets Reveal God's Supernatural Timeline

It is breathtaking, almost unsettling, to revisit the ancient prophecies of the Old Testament and behold their precision. These were not vague predictions whispered into the wind; they were declarations written across centuries, foretelling the divinity, birth, life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ with astonishing accuracy among others.

Consider this: if only eight of the more than two hundred prophecies concerning the coming of Christ had come to pass, the probability would be beyond comprehension. It would be like filling the entire state of Texas with silver dollars stacked two feet deep, painting a single coin red, blindfolding a man, and asking him to walk out and pick up that exact coin on his first try. Impossible! And yet, those prophecies were fulfilled. Not by chance. Not by coincidence. But, by the hand of the One who exists outside of time itself.

The *Timeline of End Time Events* book is focused on the “last generation”: the Biblical end of the age. The Bible’s, 66 books, penned by 40 authors, over a period of some 2000 years, is an integrated text where the Old Testament conceals the New Testament, and the New Testament reveals The Old Testament. Most End Times books rightly include hundreds of Old Testament prophecies but *Timeline of End Times Events* is primarily focused on the present day and scriptures that relate to prophetic current events. Here are a few prophecies from the Old Testament worth mentioning, that will give you a sense of how prophetically accurate the foretelling future events has been by our God.

Encrypted-Hebrew-Biblical-code

The Names of the Ten Patriarchs, Adam through Noah. If the Patriarchs names (Genesis 5:1-32) are converted from Aramaic to English the meanings of their names form the following sentence:

Man appointed (brought about) to mortal sorrow, (but) the blessed God shall come down (Jesus) teaching (that) His death shall bring the despairing (the lost and hopeless) rest (comfort) reunion with God.

2600 Years before the birth of Jesus

The Dispersion of the Jewish People

Jesus foretold the Jewish diaspora or dispersion to lands outside the land of Israel until the age of the Gentiles is fulfilled. A 2,535 year-old prophesy was realized during the period of 587 BC to 1948 AD. Could this merely be coincidence? Or was it the unmistakable hand of God moving through history? Jesus Himself foretold Israel's dispersion and exile, and that it would mark the age of the Gentiles:

They will fall by the edge of the sword and be led captive among all nations, and Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

Luke 21:24 NASB1995

Centuries earlier, Moses declared:

...then the Lord your God will restore you from captivity, and have compassion on you, and will gather you again from all the peoples where the Lord your God has scattered you.

Deuteronomy 30:3 NASB1995

The granting of statehood of Israel in 1948 by the United Nations, and U.S. President Harry Truman's recognition marked a major turning point in biblical prophecy and signaled that God's prophetic clock concerning Israel had begun moving once again.

Imagine, 2,535 years passed from the captivity of Israel until May 14th, 1948



Only a God who lives outside of time can know and foretell the future with such accuracy. God has clearly given us the signs for the end of this age and only now with the “technological” advances could the prophesies we are observing come to pass.

And now with increased knowledge we see the possibility of destroying humanity. That also has been foretold in the Book of Revelation.

Future Empires Declared

God's Book, the Bible, has declared the future empires before they appeared. Long before history recorded them, Scripture foretold in Daniel 11, the rise and fall of mighty empires: Babylonian, Medo-Persian, Greek, the Roman, and a final empire.

Revelation foretells of 7 mountains, i.e. empires. With the 5 above, add the Egyptian, and Assyrian making 7.

500 to 2,500 Years of the Future Foretold

The Birth of Christ

The most astounding of all prophecies is the coming of Jesus Christ, foretold centuries before His birth through more than 200 prophecies in the Old Testament. Again and again, Bible prophecy has proven that history is not spiraling out of control, it is unfolding according to God's divine plan.

A 4000 Year Period of Jesus' Birth Foretold

End of the Age Prophecies

Scripture revealed the signs that would mark the end of this age. For generations, many of these prophecies seemed impossible to comprehend. How could one global leader influence the entire world? How could all buying and selling be controlled? How could nations monitor populations on a worldwide

scale? How could humanity possess the power to destroy itself? Now, for the first time in human history, the technological capabilities exist to fulfill them exactly as foretold. Artificial intelligence, digital currencies, biometric systems, satellite surveillance, instantaneous global communication, and modern weapons of unimaginable destructive power have transformed what once seemed symbolic into chilling reality.

But now, we must turn from wonder to warning.

Standing at the Threshold. We are no longer merely looking back at fulfilled prophecy; we are standing at the threshold of what is soon to come. A sharp and irreversible line has been crossed in human history. Before that line, these things were unimaginable. After that line, they became everyday reality invading our peace of mind and, soon perhaps, our very existence.

As It Was in the Days of Noah

Do not mistake the present age for the Tribulation itself. Rather, we are witnessing the stage being prepared for the events yet to come. Jesus warned that the last days would be like the days before the flood. People married, built homes,

pursued their ambitions, celebrated their successes, and carrying on with life as usual, unaware that judgment stood at the threshold. Look around. We live in an age of unprecedented abundance. Comfort surrounds us. Convenience is at our fingertips. Wealth, entertainment, and endless distractions fill our days. Yet these are not the marks of judgment; they are the marks of a world asleep ignoring its need for God. This is not the storm. It is the stillness before the storm.

The question is not whether God's prophetic Word will come to pass. His promises and warnings have never failed. The question is whether we will discern the times in which we live, awaken from our complacency, and respond to His call before the door of opportunity closes.

Now is the season to seek Him and to warn others with love, not fear. Now is the time to prepare our hearts. For while the world celebrates its prosperity and security, eternity draws nearer with every passing day.

The Days Ahead

The Bible documents many events surrounding the End Times, including the rescue of true believers, not merely those who claim Christianity outwardly, but those whom God knows as His own often referred to as a remnant. A remnant is usually less than one yard of fabric on a bolt (10 to 30 yards). Scripture also warns of the terrifying darkness that will follow when the restraining influence of the Holy Spirit is removed from the earth (2 Thessalonians 2:6-7). The removal of the Holy Spirit would include the invisible Kingdom of God and the saints at the time of the rapture. Some wonder why the United States is not clearly identified in Revelation's final world events. It seems impossible considering our power and presence on today's world stage.

Here is a thought: perhaps when the believers in Jesus (salt and light) are removed at the Rapture (harpazo), the nation will collapse morally, spiritually, and physically decline as Americans destroy themselves from within. "A nation (Kingdom) divided cannot stand". Imagine the political and industrial criminals running the USA; selling off our military assets and resources to other countries like China, Russia, etc. Look what happened to Venezuela.

In 1992, Venezuela was the 3rd richest country in the Western Hemisphere, powered by oil and a growing middle class. 1998, Hugo Chávez is elected, promising to “redistribute wealth” and he promised to fix the inequality. The went from the third richest nation in the Western atmosphere to a gang of self-serving thieves and drug dealers. It could happen to the USA in months without providing the moral fiber needed for social order. The United States is experiencing a multi-billion dollar childcare scandal by a hand full of criminals. What will happen when, government, the military, and the industrial complex, and drug cartels take over. The evolutionary philosophy of survival of the fittest will sink our nation in short dis-order.

The warnings of Scripture are no longer distant shadows on the horizon. They are unfolding before our very eyes. Those few Old Testament Scriptural prophecies above should get your attention. But ask yourself, are there any End Time events we haven't checked off as we approach the end of the age?

Hundred of Biblical prophecies have been fulfilled and archeological digs prove many thought to be myths, to be true. That's another book.

Chapter 1

A Most Significant End Times Event

The Modern Prophetic Timeline Begins (1948–Present). The Rebirth of Israel. A Nation Returns After 2,535 Years.



The rebirth of Israel on May 14, 1948, may stand as *one of the greatest miracles in human history*. Against all odds, the Jewish people returned to their ancient homeland, and the modern state of Israel was born once again. Following the United Nations partition plan, the Jews secured control of their allotted portion of Palestine and declared independence before the watching world.

To many students of Bible prophecy, this historic moment fulfilled the visions of Ezekiel 36 and 37, the valley of dry bones coming back to life. It marked the regathering of the Jewish people after more than 2,500 years of exile under the Assyrians, Babylonians, Medo-Persians, Greeks, and Romans.

A Miracle Unlike Any Other

Throughout history, when a people are conquered, scattered, and taken captive, they almost always assimilate into the culture, customs, language, and beliefs of the nations who capture them. Within only a few generations, their identity usually disappears forever. But the Jewish people were different. Scattered into more than one hundred nations across the earth, they somehow preserved their identity, their ancient traditions, their covenant sign of circumcision, their belief in the God of the

Torah, and even their language. Then, against every historical precedent, they returned to their homeland. Could this merely be coincidence? Or was it the unmistakable hand of God moving through history? Jesus Himself foretold Israel's dispersion:

They will fall by the edge of the sword and be led captive among all nations, and Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

Luke 21:24

And centuries earlier, Moses declared:

Then the LORD your God will restore your fortunes and have mercy on you, and He will gather you again from all the peoples where the LORD your God has scattered you.

Deuteronomy 30:3

Israel and the Prophetic Clock

The rebirth of Israel marked a major turning point in biblical prophecy and signaled that God's prophetic clock concerning Israel had begun moving once again. Understanding the End Times requires recognizing an important distinction in Scripture:

God's assignment for the Church, the Bride of Christ, is different from God's assignment of Israel and the Jewish people.

There are patterns in the Bible one of which is *Gaps*. Gaps are periods when God accomplishes His desired plans of justice and mercy. For example, there is a gap of two thousand years between the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem in the first century, and the 6-Days War in Israel in the Twentieth Century. God's gift of mercy and salvation was extended to the Gentiles, while blinding the Jewish people for that period. Many prophecy scholars believe that Jerusalem's return to Jewish control in 1967 marked the closing stages of the "Times of the Gentiles." After what appeared to be a long prophetic pause of nearly two thousand years, Israel has once again stepped onto the center stage of world history exactly as Scripture foretold.

The nation once scattered among the nations has returned, and with its return, the modern prophetic timeline has accelerated before our eyes.



Chapter 2

The Second Significant End Times Event 1967 – The Six-Day War

The Six-Day War marked another stunning turning point in biblical prophecy and may represent the beginning of the final generation before the Rapture, the Tribulation, and the Second Coming of Jesus Christ.



In only six astonishing days, Israel defeated the surrounding Arab nations and regained control of Jerusalem, the ancient city at the very center of God's prophetic plan. For the first time in nearly 2,000 years, Jerusalem was once again under Jewish authority. To many students of prophecy, this fulfilled the words of Jesus:

***...and they will fall by the edge of the sword,
and will be led captive into all the nations; and
Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the
Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are
fulfilled.***

Luke 21:24

For centuries, Jerusalem had been dominated by Gentile powers. But in 1967, the prophetic landscape shifted dramatically. The city once trampled by the nations returned to Jewish hands, signaling to many that the "Times of the Gentiles" were entering their final stage.

Israel Returns to Center Stage

From the resurrection of Jesus Christ until modern times, the Gospel spread primarily through the Gentile world during what many call the Church Age, the age of the Bride of Christ. Meanwhile, Israel remained scattered among the some 100 plus nations for nearly 2,500 years.

But God promised that Israel would return.

For behold, days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will restore the fortunes of My people Israel and Judah... and I will bring them back to the land that I gave to their fathers.

Jeremiah 30:3

And again:

For I will take you out of the nations; I will gather you from all the countries and bring you back into your own land.

Ezekiel 36:24

Against all historical odds, that is exactly what happened. The Jewish people returned from more than one hundred nations. Israel was reborn in 1948. Jerusalem was regained in 1967. The prophetic clock had begun moving once again.

The Kingdom of God on Earth

With the resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Kingdom of God was established on earth through His followers. The terms “Kingdom of God” and “Kingdom of Heaven” describe the same divine rule. Matthew often used the phrase “Kingdom of Heaven” because Jewish audiences were reverent about speaking the name of God directly.

This Kingdom represents God's authority working *on earth as it is in Heaven*. Yet Scripture also teaches that history is moving toward a climactic conclusion when Christ Himself will return to establish His visible reign over the nations.

The Final Witness

Many believers assume the Church must completely evangelize the world before the end can come. Yet, Scripture also reveals that during the Tribulation, God will raise up powerful witnesses from Israel itself. The Jewish Messiah, Yeshua, Jesus Christ, will be revealed in a profound way to the Jewish people, and the possibility of 144,000 sealed servants of God, twelve thousand from each tribe of Israel, will proclaim His truth during the darkest period in human history. Even in judgment, God's mercy will still call mankind to repentance.

After the Church is Removed

For nearly two thousand years, the prophecies concerning Israel seemed impossible. Then suddenly, within a single generation, Israel returned as a nation, Jerusalem came back under Jewish control, and the world entered an age of technology and globalism unlike anything in human history.

Chapter 3

The Third Significant End Times Event The Rapture (Harpazo)

The stage is no longer being built.
The actors are stepping into place.
And the world is moving rapidly toward the
final chapters foretold by God in Scripture.

One of the most beautiful prophetic pictures of the Rapture is found in the ancient Jewish wedding tradition. First there is the engagement or betrothal. Marriages were usually arranged by the parents, often with the groom's father playing a central role. The betrothal (Kiddushin/Eirusin) was legally equivalent to marriage until consummation. Next, the groom would then leave to prepare a house for his bride, often for as long as a year. During this time, the bride waited expectantly, never knowing the exact hour of his return. At the unknown time when the preparation of the house is approved by the father, the father tells the son to get the bride. Then, suddenly, usually at night, and accompanied by a shout, the bridegroom would come to take his bride away to the home he

had prepared. The bride would be carried away to join her beloved, and the marriage celebration would begin. What a breathtaking picture of Christ and His Church. Jesus promised His followers:

I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself. John 14:2-3

The Bridegroom is preparing the house. The Bride is waiting. And one day, perhaps far sooner than many imagine, the shout will come. In a moment. In the twinkling of an eye. The Church will be caught away.

Behold, I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

1 Corinthians 15:51-52
NASB1995

Scripture points toward a moment when believers will be suddenly “caught up” from the earth before the outpouring of God’s judgment. The Greek word used in 1 Thessalonians 4:17 is *harpazo*, meaning “to seize,” “snatch away,” or “catch up suddenly.” 1 Thessalonians 4:14-18 reads:

For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep [a]in Jesus. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive

[b]and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a [c]shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive [d]and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord. Therefore comfort one another with these words.

It describes a supernatural event in which believers are instantly taken from the earth to meet the Lord. Many see a prophetic foreshadowing of this event in the life of Enoch, who ***“walked with God; and he was not, for God took him”*** before judgment came upon the earth in Noah’s generation. Just as Enoch was removed before the flood, the Church, the Bride of Christ, will be removed before the Tribulation begins.

The Restrainer Removed

The Apostle Paul gives another key to understanding the timing of these end time events.

And you know what restrains him now, so that in his time he will be revealed. For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way.

2 Thessalonians 2:6–7

Many believe “the Restrainer” refers to the Holy Spirit working on earth through the true Church, i.e. members of the invisible Kingdom of God. Once that restraining influence is removed, the “man of lawlessness”, the Antichrist, will be revealed openly to the world. One can conclude true Christians, those indeed, ***not*** just name, will not be on earth to see the physical anti-Christ.

This explains why the Church is notably absent from the earth during the Tribulation events beginning in Revelation chapter 4. The Bride has been taken to Heaven, and delivered from God’s wrath. Isaiah paints a remarkable picture of God sheltering His people before judgment falls:

***Come, my people, enter your chambers,
And shut your doors behind you;
Hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment,
Until the indignation is past.***

Isaiah 26:20

Jesus... rescues us from the wrath to come.

1 Thessalonians 1:10

***For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath, but
to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus
Christ.***

1 Thessalonians 5:9

The Church will be delivered from the wrath of God poured out during the Tribulation.

Chapter 4

Revelation 4–5: The Church in Heaven The Throne Room Scene

In Revelation chapter 4, the scene dramatically shifts from earth to Heaven. After the messages to the seven churches in chapters 2 and 3, the Apostle John suddenly hears a voice like a trumpet saying:

Come up here... Revelation 4:1



To many students of prophecy, this moment symbolizes the catching away (harpazo) of the Church before the wrath of God's judgments of the Tribulation unfold upon the earth. John is immediately transported into the throne room of Heaven, where he beholds a scene of overwhelming majesty, worship, and divine authority. Notice who is in Heaven.

The Twenty-Four Elders

Surrounding the throne are twenty-four elders clothed in white garments and wearing crowns of gold. These elders are often understood to represent redeemed believers in Heaven, those who have already been glorified before God's wrath is poured out upon the earth.

Some believe the twenty-four elders symbolize the completed people of God: the union of Old Testament believers and the Church. Others note their priestly role before the throne and connect them to the royal priesthood of believers described throughout Scripture. An intriguing thought emerges from this heavenly scene.

Throughout Scripture, the combined offices of *priest and king* are uniquely associated with only a few Biblical figures:

- Jesus Christ, our eternal High Priest and King
- Melchizedek, priest of God Most High
- And the redeemed Bride of Christ, called a “royal priesthood”.

Were Old Testament saints born-again when Jesus preached to those in “Paradise” who died before His resurrection? Are the 24-Elders Old and New Testament believers?

In Chapters 4 and 5 in Revelation we find myriads and myriads, and thousands of thousands, worshipping with a loud voice,

Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.

What a magnificent scene of worship and exhalation of the Lamb of God, Jesus.

Chapter 5

The Tribulation Period (Revelation 6–18) The Seven-Year Tribulation Begins

Revelation chapters 4 and 5 present Heaven in worship before the judgments of the Tribulation begin in chapter 6 with the opening of the seals. This is significant. The Church is no longer referenced as being on earth during these catastrophic judgments. Instead, the focus shifts to Israel, the nations, and the rise of the Antichrist.



The Tribulation itself unfolds in two distinct halves: The first 3½ years: the rise of the Antichrist as a global political leader promising peace and stability, the final 3½ years: often called the Great Tribulation begins when the Antichrist desecrates the Temple in Jerusalem known as the “abomination of desolation.” Jesus warned that this final period would become the worst time in human history.

For centuries, people living through wars, persecution, and global turmoil have believed they were experiencing the Tribulation. From the cruelty of Caesar to the horrors of Hitler and world wars, generations have looked at the darkness around them and assumed the end had arrived. But Jesus described these events as “birth pangs”, increasing in frequency and intensity as history moves toward its final climax. Wars, rumors of wars, famines, deception, lawlessness, and global instability are not the Tribulation itself, but warnings that the world is moving closer to it.

The Tribulation described in Revelation is unlike anything humanity has ever experienced. It is the final outpouring of God’s judgment upon a rebellious world and the closing battle in the long war between God and Satan. It culminates in the

victorious return of Jesus Christ, the defeat of the Antichrist, and Satan's and the False Prophets imprisonment during Christ's millennial reign.

The Restrainer Removed

According to this prophetic understanding, true believers will *not* witness the rise of the Antichrist because the Church will already have been caught away into Heaven. Paul writes:

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout... and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.

1 Thessalonians 4:16–17

Notice that believers meet Christ “in the air,” which differs from His visible Second Coming to the earth described elsewhere in Scripture. In Acts 1:11, the angels declared:

This same Jesus... will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven.

At His Second Coming, Christ returns physically to the earth in power and glory. The Rapture and the Second Coming are separated by at least seven-years of the Tribulation period.

Salt, Light, and the Restraining Force

The Holy Spirit lives within believers, and through the Church God restrains evil in the world. Jesus called His followers the “salt of the earth” and the “light of the world.” The removal of this restraining influence opens the door for unprecedented lawlessness and the rise of the Antichrist. From the beginning, Scripture foretold conflict between Satan and the purposes of God:

And I will put enmity between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed.

Genesis 3:15

Paul later warned in 2 Thessalonians 2:7:

The mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way.

Then the “lawless one,” empowered by Satan, will be revealed openly to the world.

Does the Rapture Proceed the Tribulation?

If the Rapture occurred at the exact same moment as Christ’s visible return to earth with King Jesus, several prophetic questions become difficult to reconcile.

- How can the restraining influence of the Church be removed before the Antichrist rises if believers

remain on earth throughout the Tribulation?

- How can believers be “caught up” to meet Christ in the air while, simultaneously, Christ is descending to establish His Kingdom on earth?
- And when would the marriage supper of the Lamb occur if the Church does not enter Heaven as He returns?

These questions have led many believers to conclude that the Rapture occurs before the Tribulation begins. This understanding also explains:

- Why the Church is quietly missing on earth during Revelation chapters 6–18
- Why Revelation 4:1 (“Come up here”) is viewed symbolically by some as the Church being called to Heaven.
- Why Daniel’s prophecies maintain a distinction between Israel and the Church.
- Why Scripture repeatedly emphasizes the imminence of Christ’s return, that He could come at any moment

The Rise of the Antichrist

Once the restraining force is removed, the Antichrist rises to global prominence.

Daniel 7:8 states,

...whose appearance was greater than his fellows.

Daniel 8:23 says,

A king shall arise, having fierce features, who understands sinister schemes.

Daniel 11:36

He shall exalt and magnify himself above every god.

Revelation 13:4

Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?

And 2 Thessalonians 2:9-10 describe him powerful political leader empowered directly by Satan. He will promise peace, stability, and solutions for a world descending into chaos.

...the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders, and with all the deception of wickedness.

The Tribulation begins with the Seal Judgments described in Revelation 6:

False peace, War, Famine, Death, and Global upheaval and fear.



At first, the Antichrist appears as a savior to the nations. But beneath the mask of peace lies a terrifying reality.

The Abomination of Desolation

Three and a half years into the Tribulation, the Antichrist reveals his true nature. As foretold in Daniel 9:27 and warned by Jesus in Matthew 24:15, he enters the rebuilt Temple in Jerusalem and declares himself to be God. This event is called the “abomination of desolation.” It echoes the actions of Antiochus Epiphanies, who desecrated the Temple in the second century BC, foreshadowing the ultimate rebellion still to come. From this moment forward, the world enters the darkest period in human history.

The Great Tribulation

The final 3½ years are known as the Great Tribulation. During this time, God's judgments intensify through:

- The Trumpet Judgments (Revelation 8–9).
- The Bowl Judgments (Revelation 16).
- Widespread devastation across the earth
- Severe persecution of Israel and Tribulation believers.
- Jesus warned that unless those days were shortened, no flesh would survive.
-

The world that rejected God's mercy will experience the full consequences of rebellion.

Israel's Role During the Tribulation

Although the Church is in Heaven, God's plan for Israel continues. Scripture indicates that 144,000 sealed Jewish servants of God will proclaim the Gospel throughout the world during the Tribulation. Through unimaginable suffering and refinement, many in Israel will finally recognize Jesus as Messiah. God's ever lasting covenant with the Jewish people is confirmed by Paul as he wrote:

And so all Israel will be saved.

Romans 11:26

Zechariah prophesied:

They will look on Me whom they pierced.

Zechariah 12:10

Israel will pass through the fire of testing, but God's covenant promises will not fail. The same God who scattered Israel among the nations will complete His redemptive plan for His Jewish people before history reaches its final conclusion.

For those saints that believe God has passed His promises on to the saints of the Church and that the Jewish people (a true remnant-1% to 2% on a role of cloth) consider Romans chapter 8 through 12. Clarity is experience when we realize there are two different destinies of the Jewish people and the Bride; the church. God has gaps in His timeline of the story of humanity. The Age of the Gentiles, the bride-church, of two thousand years, illustrates just that.

The Bible is an extraterrestrial book written by God outside of time and space, with the New Testament Concealed in the Old Testament, and the Old testament revealed in the New Testament. There are more that 30,000 hyperlinks from the Old Testament to the New Testament and New Testament to the Old Testament.

The Antichrist is Satan's Counterfeit Christ

A summary of the Tribulation conflict might be like this:

The Antichrist empowered by Satan is a gifted political leader, persuasive orator, military conqueror, economic ruler, miracle-working deceiver, and self-proclaimed god. His brief global kingdom ends instantly at the glorious appearing of Jesus Christ.

Jesus' promises are His promises! His Word and covenants are forever. Jews are the apple of His eye. The covenant with the Jewish people, is for a thousand generations. I would be careful modifying His covenants with predetermined concepts. Do your research and verify your beliefs with the incontrovertible, unchanging, irreversible truths in the Word of God; including every word of this book. As for the true student knows...

It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter.

Proverbs 25:2 KJV

Chapter 6

The Second Coming of Christ Christ Returns in Power



The Second Coming of Jesus Christ is the climactic event toward which all biblical prophecy moves. It is the glorious return of Christ to the earth in power, majesty, and judgment.

At His first coming, Jesus entered the world in humility, as the suffering servant, born in a manger, rejected by men, and crucified for the sins of humanity. But His second coming will be entirely different. He will return openly and visibly as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

Jesus declared:

Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven... and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Matthew 24:30

This will not be a hidden event or a private revelation witnessed by only a few. The nations of the earth will see Him. The same world that rejected Him will behold Him returning in unimaginable glory.

The King Comes to Judge the Nations

The Second Coming is not only a moment of victory, it is also a moment of judgment.

Jesus said:

When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. All the nations will be gathered before Him.

Matthew 25:31–32

At this judgment, Christ separates the righteous from the wicked, often described as the separation of the sheep from the goats. Many understand this as the judgment of the nations that occurs at the close of the Tribulation, distinct from the Great White Throne Judgment that takes place after the Millennial Kingdom. Every kingdom that exalted itself against God will fall. Every rebellion will be exposed. Every hidden evil will stand before the righteous Judge of all the earth.

The Defeat of the Antichrist

For seven terrifying years, the Antichrist will dominate the world through deception, political power, and satanic authority. But his reign ends instantly when Christ appears.

Paul wrote:

The Lord will consume [the lawless one] with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.

2 Thessalonians 2:8

The Antichrist, who once seemed unstoppable, will be utterly powerless before the returning Christ. Human armies, global alliances, and demonic powers will collapse in a single moment before the authority of the Son of God.



Revelation 19: Heaven Opens

Revelation 19 presents one of the most breathtaking scenes in all of Scripture. Heaven opens, and Jesus appears riding on a white horse, clothed in righteousness and crowned with many crowns. And on His robe and on His thigh, He has a name written:

KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Revelation 19:16

Chapter 7

The Millennial Reign of Christ Satan Bound, and the Kingdom Established



After the devastating events of the Tribulation and the triumphant return of Jesus Christ, Scripture reveals a breathtaking new era upon the earth, the Millennial Kingdom.

Jesus returns with His saints in glory, and with the mere breath of His mouth He defeats the nations and armies gathered against Him.

And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse.

Revelation 19:21

The rebellion of mankind is crushed instantly before the authority of the returning King.

Satan Bound for One Thousand Years

Revelation 20 declares that Satan himself is seized and bound for one thousand years:

He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years.

Revelation 20:2

The Millenial Reign

- For the first time since the fall of mankind in the Garden of Eden, the deceiver of the nations is removed from influencing the world.
- Christ then establishes His Kingdom on earth and reigns physically from Jerusalem as the rightful King over all nations.
- This is the long-awaited fulfillment of countless prophecies concerning the Messiah's reign.

- The promises of God to Israel are finally fulfilled.
- Israel is restored in her homeland.
- Jerusalem becomes the center of Messiah's Kingdom.
- And Jesus Christ rules the earth in righteousness, justice, and peace.
- The curse of war is lifted. The nations come under the authority of the King of Kings. The world experiences a foretaste of the restoration God intended from the beginning.
- There will be Glorified and Natural Bodies During the Millennium. Scripture indicates that two kinds of people will inhabit the earth: Believers who return with Christ in glorified bodies and Survivors of the Tribulation who remain in natural human bodies
- Jesus Himself demonstrated aspects of a glorified body after His resurrection. He appeared suddenly, yet could also eat and fellowship with His disciples.
- During this thousand-year reign, life continues on earth. Families grow, children are born, nations exist, and the population of the earth begins rebuilding after the catastrophic judgments of the Tribulation. Some estimate that only a fraction of humanity survives the Great Tribulation.
- The Final Rebellion

- Yet even after one thousand years of Christ's righteous rule, the human heart still reveals mankind's free will.
- At the end of the Millennium, Satan is released for a brief time to deceive the nations once more. Those born during the Millennial reign who have never truly submitted their hearts to Christ will join this final rebellion.
- But it ends quickly and decisively.
- Fire comes down from Heaven, and Satan's rebellion is destroyed forever.
- Then comes the final judgment.

The Great White Throne Judgment

Revelation 20 describes the most sobering courtroom scene in all of eternity—the Great White Throne Judgment.

Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away...

Revelation 20:11

All unbelieving dead stand before God. The books are opened, and every person is judged according to their works.

And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.

Revelation 20:12



Finally;

- The beast is seized.
- The false prophet is judged.
- The world that longed for peace, justice, and righteous leadership, is realized.
- Jesus establishes a Kingdom that cannot be shaken.
- The Savior who once wore a crown of thorns will return wearing many crowns.
- The Lamb who was slain returns as the Lion of Judah.
- The rejected Messiah will return as the rightful ruler of the nations.

...so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of

those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 2:10-11

This is not a judgment to determine rewards for believers as previously mentioned, but the final judgment upon those who rejected God's salvation. Death itself is defeated. Sin is fully judged. And Satan, the ancient enemy of mankind is cast forever into the lake of fire.

The End of Evil

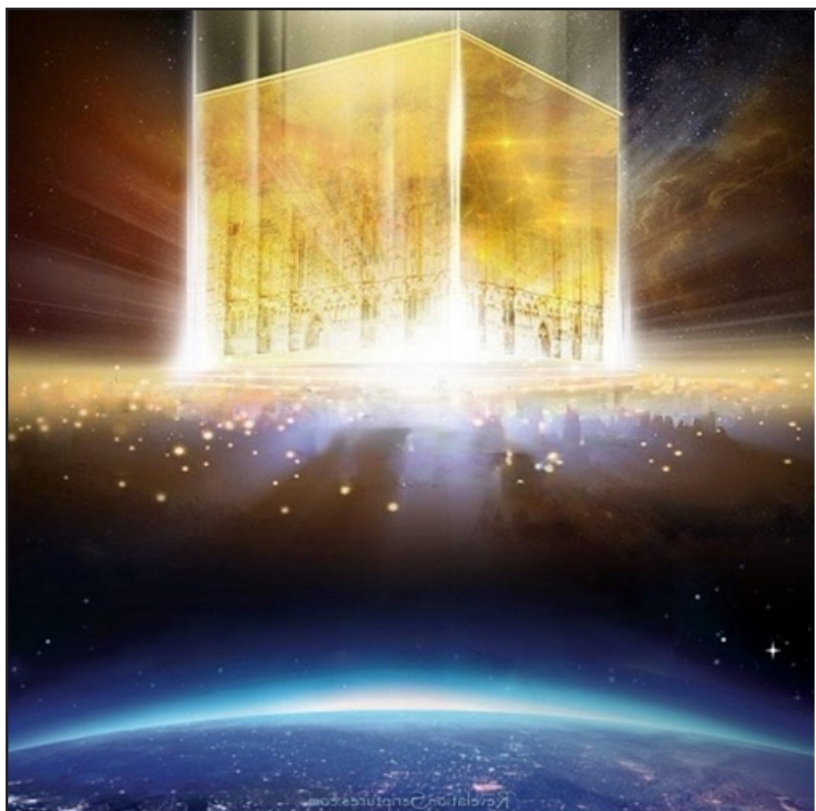
The long war that began in Eden finally comes to an end.

Chapter 8

At last, after the final judgment and the complete defeat of sin, death, and Satan, Scripture reveals the breathtaking climax of God's eternal plan, the New Heaven and the New Earth.

This is the eternal state: a renewed creation where God dwells forever with His people in perfect peace, holiness, and joy. The long tragedy that began in Eden finally comes to its glorious conclusion.

John writes:

Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away.

Revelation 21:1



The old world, corrupted by sin, suffering, decay, and death, passes away forever. In its place, God creates a renewed and perfected order untouched by evil.

From His throne, God declares:

“Behold, I make all things new.”

Revelation 21:5

And again, every effect of the curse is removed.

- No more corruption.
- No more sorrow.
- No more pain.
- No more death.
- No more separation from God.

What mankind lost through sin in the Garden of Eden is fully restored through Jesus Christ. This fulfills the ancient prophecy spoken through Isaiah:

For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth.

Isaiah 65:17

History does not end in chaos. It ends in restoration.

The New Jerusalem

John then beholds one of the most magnificent sights in all of Scripture:

The holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Revelation 21:2



The New Jerusalem descends in unimaginable beauty and glory. It is the eternal dwelling place of God with His redeemed people. The imagery of the Bride reminds us once again that God's relationship with His people is not distant or mechanical, it is intimate, eternal, and filled with covenant love.

Then comes the greatest promise ever spoken:
“Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them.

Revelation 21:3

No temple is needed there, for God Himself fills all things with His presence.

And there shall be no more curse.

Revelation 22:3

Every wound caused by sin is healed. The rebellion of mankind is over. Death itself has been destroyed. The sorrow of history gives way to eternal joy in the presence of God. The River of Life and the Tree is Restored. John describes a pure river flowing from the throne of God:

And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal...

Revelation 22:1

And there, once again, is the Tree of Life. The very tree lost in Eden because of sin, is restored in eternity. What was closed to mankind after the fall is reopened forever through the victory of Jesus Christ. Paradise lost becomes paradise restored. Eternity Begins. The Bible closes not with destruction, but with hope. Not with darkness, but with light. Not with death, but with everlasting life. God's people will dwell with Him forever in a Kingdom without end. The Savior who redeemed mankind will reign eternally with His people. The faithful will see His face. And the story of redemption will be complete.

The final words of Revelation echo across the centuries as both promise and warning:

Surely I am coming quickly.

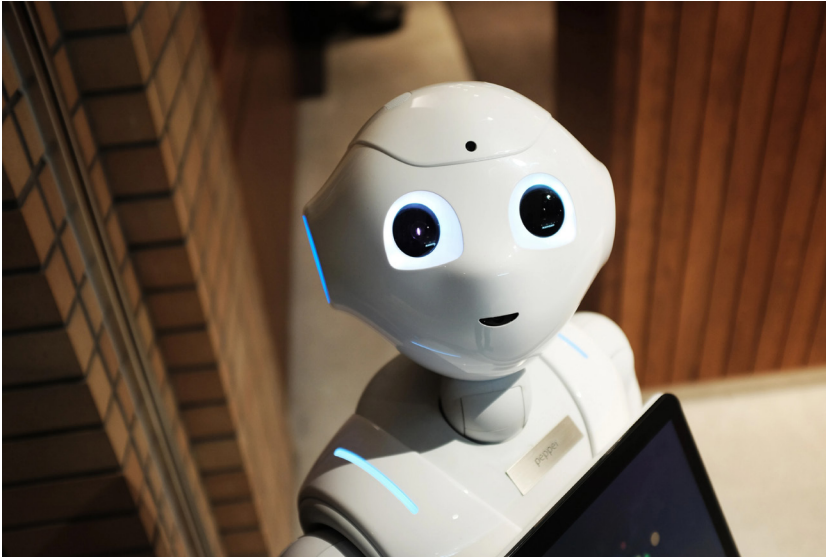

Chapter 9

Ai in the Bible Bible Prophecy and Ai in the End Times?



The term “AI” does not appear in the Bible. But some consider the possibility of the of the second beast (the False Prophet) giving life or breath to the image of the Beast in Revelation 13.

Note this is the second beast, two horns, not ten like the first beast. This beast is referred to as the False Prophet. The key passage is:

And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.”

Revelation 13:15 KJV

Other translations render “life” as “breath”:
“It was permitted to give breath to the image of the (first) beast,

This has fascinated prophecy students for centuries because John describes:

- An image of the Beast.
- The image appears to come alive.
- The image speaks.
- The image exercises authority.
- The image participates in identifying and condemning dissenters.

For most of church history, commentators struggled to imagine how a global image could “speak.” Proposed explanations included:

- A supernatural demonic miracle.
- An idol animated by evil spirits.
- Symbolic political propaganda.
- Some future technology unknown to John's audience.

In recent years, many have suggested that advanced artificial intelligence, robotics, biometric surveillance, and global communications could provide a mechanism by which such a prophecy might literally occur. They note that we now have technologies capable of:

- Creating lifelike digital avatars.
- Speaking in real time.
- Monitoring populations.
- Identifying individuals.
- Making autonomous decisions.

This has led some to speculate that the “image of the Beast” could be: an AI-controlled system, a humanoid robotic representation of the Beast, or a global digital avatar. Possibly a technologically empowered idol demanding allegiance. It simply says that the False Prophet gives breath to the image so that it speaks and enforces worship.

There is another intriguing passage:
*And he deceiveth them that dwell on the
earth by the means of those miracles
which he had power to do...*

Revelation 13:14

This suggests that whatever happens involves deception and astonishing signs, which could be supernatural, technological, or a combination of both.

For nearly 1,900 years, Revelation 13 sounded impossible. How could a single image communicate with the whole world and monitor compliance? Today, with satellite networks, digital surveillance, facial recognition, and AI-driven systems, people can at least envision how such a scenario might unfold. Whether AI is involved or not, the technology now exists to make a literal reading of the passage seem far less far-fetched than it did in previous centuries.

Chapter 10

As it Was in the Days of Noah

One of the greatest books I recommend on the Biblical account of the pre-flood era is by a 19th Century Bible scholar named G. H. Pember. The book named *Earth's Earliest Ages* was a gift from a pastor who must have saw something in my wife and me that changed the course in our lives. Eschatology, the study of end times, became my favorite subject.

G. H. Pember's knowledge of the Bibles original language reveals a story of fallen angels, giants, and a thirst of Satan to destroy the human blood line that was required for the New Covenant to be established, through the sacrifice of our Lord and Savior, Jesus. There are 225 pages dedicated to the pre-flood age that is a must to read for any Christian who loves the greatest book ever written, the Bible.

Jesus said in Matthew 24: 37, ***As it was in the days of Noah, so will it be at the coming of the Son of Man.*** Of the 100 million to 1 billion people on the earth only 8 were righteous and had a pure blood line required for the Messiah to accomplish God's plan: pay the price for man's sins and offer eternal salvation as it began in the Garden of Eden. It require God to destroyed all but Noah and his family. Jesus said;

For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and they did not understand until the flood came and took them all away; so will the coming of the Son of Man be.

Matthew 24: 38-39

Look around. The masses do not understand what is about to happen. The signs of the time with a culture of violence, carnal knowledge, wealth, sexual confusion, pride, hate, wars, moral decay, and more, are comparable to Sodom and Gomorrah and we know what God thought about them. The spiritual wickedness we face each day before our eyes is liken to fallen angels destroying all the good God had made. What do you think is about to happen?

Chapter 11

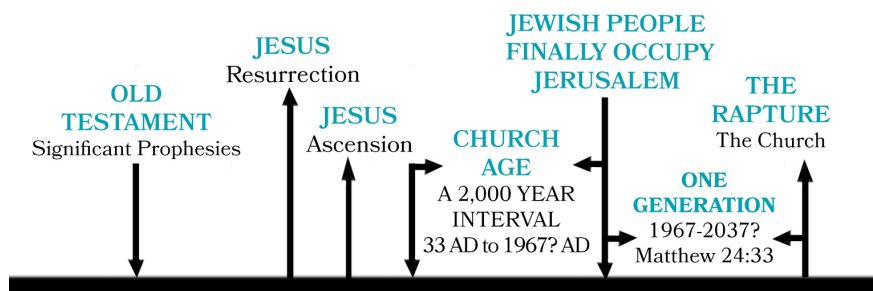
A Summary of End Time Events

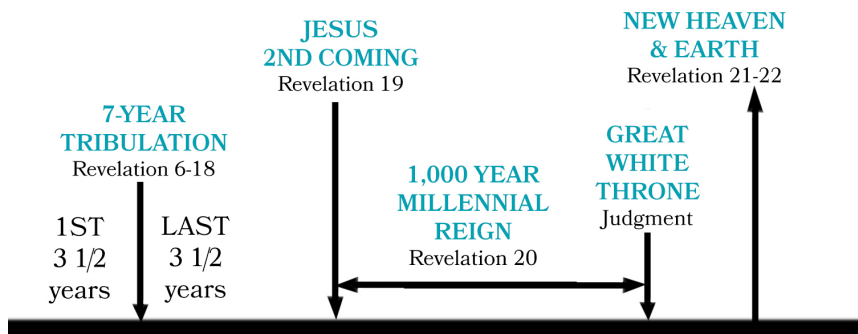

Summary of the Main End Time Events

- Israel became a nation in 1948.
- The Six-Day War in 1967 gave the Jewish people political and military possession, and control of the land of Israel after 2,500 years of dispersion.
- On December 6, 2017, the United States of America officially recognized Jerusalem as the capital city of the State of Israel, affirming the historic return of the Jewish people.
- Rapture of the Believers. Believers escape God's wrath.
- The Church is in Heaven and is missing for the most part after Chapter 3 in Revelation with regard to God's wrath.
- Before judgment falls, Heaven worships.
- Revelation 4 and 5 reveals the Lamb of God—Jesus Christ—standing as though slain, yet alive forevermore. Only He is worthy to open the seals containing the judgments and final redemption of the earth.
- The throne room erupts with worship:
- “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain...” Revelation 5:12
- The same Jesus who came first as Savior will return as King.
- The same Lamb who offered mercy will one day judge the nations.
- And before the storm of judgment begins, the redeemed stand safely before the throne, clothed in white, worshipping the One who conquered death itself.

- The destiny of the Jewish people who experience an interval of almost 2000 years are then in place as promised by God. Their final assignment begins. Rev 6
- With the removal of the Church (Bride) the Antichrist appears and comes to power as a political leader; for the first 3½ years of the Tribulation. This can only occur if that (the Holy Spirit and Kingdom of God) which is holding him (the Antichrist) is taken out of his (Satan) way.
- The Temple is finally rebuilt before the 3½ year mid-point of the Tribulation. Plans are in place for the Jewish people to return to the past temple activities before the temple was destroyed (70 AD).
- The Antichrist becomes a powerful military leader.
- After 3½ years, the Antichrist sets up his image in the Holy of Holies. This is known as the Abomination of Desolation, as Antiochus Epiphanies defiled the Temple between 175 BC and his death in 164 BC
- The Antichrist establishes a One World Government.
- The second beast, the False Prophet, appears and causes the image of the beast to speak (AI?). Revelation 13:15
- The second beast performs miracles and causes people to worship the Beast. Revelation 13:15
- The Beast will make war with the Prostitute, i.e. the Kings and Political leaders with power and influence (riches, sorcery, immorality, idolatry). Revelation 17:15
- Ten Kings arise for a short while and give their

power to the beast. Revelation 17:12

- The Beast, i.e., the Antichrist, defeats the Whore of Babylon, who represent the carnal, wealthy people, and systems of the world. Revelation 17
- Babylon has fallen. Revelation 18
- The Wedding Feast occurs in Heaven. The exact time is not given but it is apparent it will occur sometime between the Rapture and the Second Coming.
- The Second Coming to earth of Christ with His Bride occurs.
- Jesus will separate the righteous from the wicked, the sheep from the goats. This is understood as the judgment of the nations.
- Satan is defeated, bound, and imprisoned for 1,000 years.
- The Millennial Reign begins. There is no temptation of Satan; but free will still exists.
- At the end of the Millennial Reign, Satan will be released for a short while. Those born in the flesh will be tempted and then the Great White Throne Judgment will occur (Revelation 20:11–15)
- At last the New Heaven and earth are revealed. Revelation 21 and 22.

Hopefully you will realize from the past few pages there is a God Who said thousands of years ago:

***I am God, and there is none like Me,
declaring the end from the beginning...***

The conclusion, when all has been heard, is: fear God and keep His commandments, because this applies to every person.

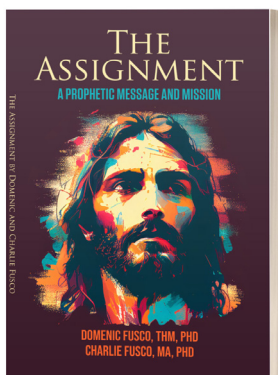

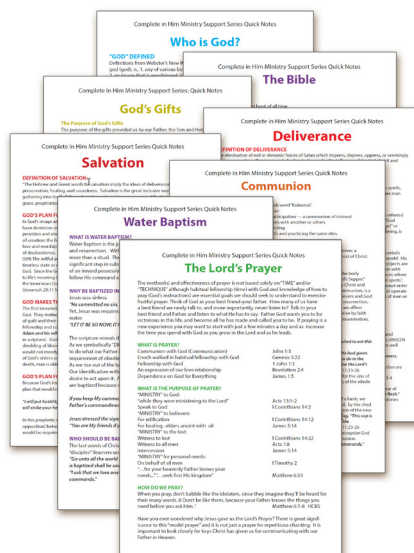

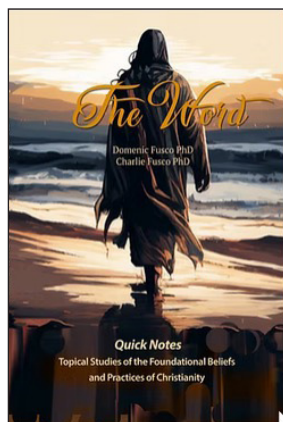
